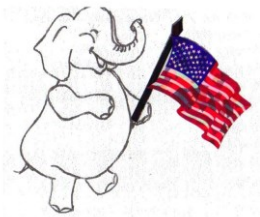

**Update on 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment Rights**

IP43 and IP44 will not be on the ballot this November thanks to all the hardworking people who expressed concerns about the initiatives and their impact on everyone's 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment Rights. The Oregon Supreme Court recently ruled that IP43 Ballot title was vague and needed to be rewritten by the Oregon Attorney General. Supporters had until July 6<sup>th</sup> to gather over 88,000 signatures to get it on the November ballot.
