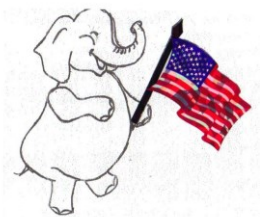

If you're ever wondered why state agencies in Oregon seem to be caught with their pants down so often with fraud, waste and abuse, Secretary of State Dennis Richardson may have an answer for you: They aren't bothering to look for it or limit the risk. Richardson's office issued an audit Wednesday lambasting state agencies internal audit functions, saying they had been consistently understaffed, undervalued and neglected by leadership, so much so that agency directors are largely unaware of the activities of their auditors - if they even have one. November Ballot Measures

Measure 102, it allows local governments to issue bonds to pay for affordable housing projects that involve nonprofits or other nongovernmental entities.

Measure 103, which would amend Oregon’s Constitution to ban taxes on food and groceries.

Measure 104, which would amend Oregon's Constitution to require a three-fifths supermajority vote in the Legislature to trim tax breaks or raise fees.

Measure 105, which would repeal Oregon's sanctuary state status.

Measure 106, which would ban state funding for abortions in Oregon
