After much discussion with different members and the community the party is creating a strategy as to how best to assist our candidates so that people in the districts have a choice as to who represents them.

Phase Zero was our candidates winning the primaries.

We are now in Phase One – Connecting our House Captains with the Candidates to build a grassroots team.

Phase Two – Creating specific based arguments as to why our candidates are better to represent all citizens in the House Districts and Statewide. Also to raise the necessary funds to be competitive in the races.

Phase Three – Fall Campaign Blitz. Getting out into the communities and sharing the message of our candidates

Phase Four – Winning in November and bring balance back to the State.
